ORDER

As per Government order read above, Letter of Intent/No Objection Certificate was granted to Chaitanya Eye Hospital & Research Institute, Kesavadasapuram, Thiruvananthapuram for starting Diploma in Ophthalmic Assistance (DOA) course in the Self Financing Sector. Subsequently as per the application read as 2nd paper above, the institution has requested Government to grant Letter of Permission for starting Diploma in Ophthalmic Assistance (DOA) course during 2010-11. The Director of Medical Education has reported that the institution satisfies all norms set by the the Paramedical Council for starting the course, in the institution, with an intake of 10 (Ten). The Paramedical Council on 07.05.2010 has recommended to start the course in the institution from the academic year 2010-11. The institution has produced Bank Guarantee of Rs. 10 lakhs and has executed Agreement with Government in terms of fees and admission.

2. Government having examined the case in detail are pleased to grant Letter of Permission to Chaitanya Eye Hospital & Research Institute, Kesavadasapuram,

Thiruvananthapuram for starting Diploma in Ophthalmic Assistance (DOA) course with student intake of 10 (Ten), during 2010-11, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The institution shall abide by the Agreement executed with Government to admit 50% seats on merit quota from the list prepared by the Director of Medical Education and as per the rate of fee fixed by Government from time to time. 50% seats shall be Management seats, which shall be filled on Merit.
- ii. The admission shall be based on prospectus issued by the Director of Medical Education for each year
- iii. Letter of Permission will be withdrawn if any of the above conditions is violated.

3. The Director of Medical Education shall include the institution in the Prospectus for admission to Paramedical Diploma courses 2010-11 and allot students to the 50% of the Merit seats in the institution from the total of 10 (Ten) seats, for starting the course, from the State merit list prepared for the year 2010-11


