ORDER

FMS Memorial Co-operative Hospital & Research Centre, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram has submitted application to Government for starting Paramedical Diploma courses viz. Diploma in Operation Theatre Technology (DOTT) and Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) courses in their College of Paramedical Sciences, Perinthalmanna. The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the inspection report and as per the report the institution has sufficient infrastructure and other facilities to start the two courses. The institution has produced Bank Guarantee of Rs. 10 lakhs and has executed Agreement with Government in terms of admission and fees.

2. Government, having examined the case in detail, are pleased to grant Letter of Permission to College of Paramedical Sciences, Perinthalmanna run by EMS Memorial Co-operative Hospital & Research Centre, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram for starting the following courses with intake noted against each from 2010-11.

Sl.No.	Courses	Student Intake
1.	Diploma in Operation Theatre Technology (DOTT)	15 (Fifty)
2.	Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT)	30 (Thirty)

3. The Letter of Permission granted shall be subject to the following conditions:-
- The institution shall abide by the Agreement executed with Government to admit 50% seats on merit quota from the list prepared by the Director of Medical Education/Director, LBS Centre and as per the rate of fee fixed by Government from time to time. 50% seats shall be Management seats, which shall be filled on Merit.
 - The admission shall be based on prospectus issued by the Director of Medical Education for each year.
 - Letter of Permission will be withdrawn if any of the above conditions is violated.

4. The Director of Medical Education/Director, LBS Centre shall include the institution in the Prospectus for admission to Professional Diploma courses 2010-11 and allot students to the 50% of the Merit seats in the institution for starting the courses, from the State Rank list prepared for the year 2010-11.
